Dear Families,

Welcome to the 2024-2025 Faith Formation year! We are excited to begin this new year using new learning materials. We are inviting 1st through 8th grade students to register. Our First Communion and Confirmation programs are two-year programs. Students are required to attend 1st & 2nd grade to receive the Sacrament of First Communion and 7th & 8th grades to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Families are invited and strongly encouraged to attend Mass on Saturday or Sunday. Mass is an important message to your children. Sunday Mass is a great opportunity for RE families to come together and worship with others in the St. Luke community and to receive Eucharist. We know that parents are the first teachers of their children and what you model is most important.

Religious Education is intended to be an ongoing program. Expectations are that children remain in the program throughout their grade and middle school years and not attend just to receive the Sacraments. Attached you will find a Registration form, Diocese of Joliet Permission/Medical Release for Minor's Form, calendar, and other information to keep you informed. Kindly complete the forms attached before August 30th. Tuition is \$175.00 for one child, \$50.00 for the second child and any additional children in your family are free. Children receiving First Communion or Confirmation have an additional \$50.00 sacramental fee, this is a one-time fee.
